ORDERING SPARE PARTS

IMPORTANT

Your Shear Bucket is a made up of a Machine assembly number (common parts), specific sub assemblies and also customer optional build kits. The machine, sub assemblies and optional kit numbers are listed in the front pages of your Operators manual, part no. 2163 0108. If you do not have these numbers please contact Shelbourne Reynolds Parts Department direct on (telephone) 01359 251231.

To ensure that you order the correct part from your SRE dealer please use the following procedure.

ALWAYS QUOTE THE MACHINE AND SERIAL NUMBERS WHEN ORDERING.

Refer to the Parts Manuals front page/s, listing the machine assemblies. Select the correct machine assembly number which is printed in the top left corner of the page (starting with 2599_ _ 01), This machine number can also be taken off the Shear Bucket identification plate located on the front of the main chassis beam.

On this page you will find the parts listing for the common parts for every configuration of that machine assembly number.

You will find the corresponding drawing by either looking at the facing page or progressing through the manual to the next drawing.

The drawings indicate the components by item numbers, which you will find, are repeated in the left-hand side of your parts listing, and therefore referring to the correct part.

Note all parts will not be found listed below the machine number. Other parts will be from specific sub assemblies and optional kits. These sub assemblies and kits will be found in numerical order further through the manual. Sub assemblies start with 2590_ _ 01 and kits start with KIT- 25 _ _ _ .

INTRODUCTION

The Shear Bucket is designed to both cut and hold blocks of Silage or other forms of animal feed, and then used to unload into suitable feeding arrangements. The bottom base has wear strips on it which help protect the blade and act as scrapers to ensure a clean floor at the dump area.

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STANDARD WARRANTY POLICY

1.5.1 MACHINE REGISTRATION

To qualify for the full benefit of the warranty set out in clause 1.5.2 of this warranty policy (the "Warranty"), it is the buyer's responsibility to ensure that the selling dealer has completed the warranty registration details and that they are submitted to Shelbourne Reynolds Engineering Ltd. within 30 days from the date of delivery. Using the machine implies the knowledge and acceptance of these warranty terms.

1.5.2 NEW MACHINE WARRANTY

All new machines supplied by **Shelbourne Reynolds Engineering Ltd**. ("**Shelbourne**"), are warranted to the original purchaser, under normal use and service, to be free from defects in material and workmanship for a period of 12 months from the date of delivery to the original purchaser (the **Warranty Period**), subject to the terms set out in this warranty policy.

No other warranty is given by Shelbourne regarding the machine, and no person has any authority to give any such warranty for or on behalf of Shelbourne, other than where given in writing signed by a director of Shelbourne.

1.5.3 WARRANTY CLAIMS

All claims must be submitted by a Shelbourne authorised dealer providing that the original purchaser has;

- 1) given notice in writing with full information regarding the failure, to Shelbourne (or the Shelbourne authorised dealer) during the Warranty Period, and within 15 days of the failure;
- given Shelbourne (or the Shelbourne authorised dealer) a reasonable opportunity of examining the machine or the damaged or defective parts;
- if requested by Shelbourne, returned the damaged or defective parts (via the original Shelbourne authorised dealer) within 30 days of notification of a defect;

then Shelbourne shall, at its opinion, repair or replace the defective parts, or refund the price of the defective parts.

1.5.4 REPAIR COSTS

The original purchaser or Shelbourne authorised dealer shall not repair, or arrange for a repair, of the machine without the prior written authority of Shelbourne. Such authority may only be given by Shelbourne service personnel. Shelbourne will not be liable for the cost of any repairs carried out without its prior written consent to the work being done.

If Shelbourne authorises a repair of the machine, all claims for repair costs must be submitted to Shelbourne by a Shelbourne authorised dealer within 15 days of the date of repair on a Shelbourne Warranty Claim Form.

Repairs should be completed by a Shelbourne authorised dealer (or another repairer with the prior written consent of Shelbourne).

The submission of a claim is not a guarantee of payment. Shelbourne will only reimburse the reasonable costs and expenses incurred in connection with any repair. The decision reached by Shelbourne is final.

1.5.5 EXCLUSIONS

Shelbourne will not be liable for the machine's failure to comply with the Warranty in any of the following circumstances:

- 1) damage due to improper use or abusive operation
- 2) damage or depreciation caused by normal wear and tear;
- 3) the machine has been subjected to alteration, modification or fitment of non-genuine Shelbourne parts without the prior consent of Shelbourne;
- accidental damage, including (but not limited to) damage caused by foreign objects (e.g. stones, metals and any materials other than those suitable for the machines intended use);
- 5) the machine has been neglected and not maintained and serviced fully in accordance with the details and maintenance schedule set out in the Operators Manual, and only using Shelbourne genuine parts. Proof of service work may be requested prior to approval of any claim under the Warranty;
- 6) failure due to use of incorrect oil or lubricants, contamination of the oil, or oil which has served its useful life or failure to carry out proper maintenance as recommended in the Shelbourne Operators Manual;
- 7) where the original purchaser has continued to use the machine after they became (or should reasonably have become) aware of the defect with the machine.

Continued use of the machine after a defect is discovered could cause further failures for which Shelbourne cannot be held liable and may also have safety implications.

- 8) the Shelbourne serial number plate on the machine has been removed or altered;
- 9) failure by the customer to release the machine for repair will not be accepted as a reason for delay in repair or submitting warranty claims.

The Warranty shall not apply in respect of any:

- 1) wearing items which includes flails, skids, blades or any other items which are considered to be a normal wearing or consumable items such as chains, bearings and belts;
- hoses that have suffered external damage, unless the damage is a direct result of poor routing during assembly. Complete hoses must be returned for warranty within this period. Any which have been cut or repaired will be rejected;
- 3) repeat or additional repairs resulting from incorrect diagnostics, unless advised by Shelbourne.
- 4) poor-quality previous repair work.

1.5.6 LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY

Shelbourne and the Shelbourne authorised dealer shall not be liable to the original purchaser under any circumstance for injuries, death, property damage or damages of any kind whatsoever directly, consequential or contingent to any person or property caused by the use of the machine.

Shelbourne shall not be liable for any consequential loss such as the following costs or types of loss (whether direct or indirect):

- 1) Loss of profit;
- 2) Loss of or damage to goodwill;
- 3) Loss of sales or business;
- 4) Loss of agreements or contracts or business opportunity;
- 5) The cost of lost consumables (such as oil);
- 6) Any loss or costs arising from the inability to use the machine due to any defect with the machine, and during the time taken to repair or replace the machine;
- 7) The cost of hire or purchase of any replacement machine;
- 8) Recovery of broken-down machine;
- 9) Damage to or loss of crops or vegetation;
- 10) Damage to the carrying tractor, loader or combine;
- 11)Damage caused by exceeding the tractor, loader or combine OEM (original equipment manufacturers) specification for implement mounting and hitch capability;
- 12) Any other indirect or consequential loss;

In view of the Warranty given by Shelbourne, the terms implied by sections 13 to 15 of the Sale of Goods Act 1979, and all other implied warranties or conditions regarding the quality or suitability of the machine, are, to the fullest extent permitted by law, excluded from this warranty policy and any contract or agreement between Shelbourne and either the original purchaser or the Shelbourne authorised dealer.

Nothing in this warranty policy limits any liability which cannot legally be limited, including liability for:

1) death or personal injury caused by negligence;

- 2) fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation;
- 3) breach of the terms implied by section 12 of the Sale of Goods Act 1979 (title and guiet possession); and
- 4) breach of section 2 of the Consumer Protection Act 1987.

1.5.7 WARRANTY ON SPARE PARTS

Shelbourne warrants that any spare part or component supplied by Shelbourne in accordance with this limited warranty are free from defects in material or workmanship from the date of sale to the original purchaser for 6 months, subject to the conditions and limitations in clauses 1.5.4 to 1.5.6 of this warranty policy. Shelbourne will at its option, either repair or replace the defective part free of charge providing that any warranty claim is supported with a copy of the invoice to the end user for the failed part. Original Purchaser shall be responsible for labour and all freight charges to and from the place where the warranty work is performed.

Shelbourne Reynolds Engineering Ltd. cannot be held responsible for any failures or safety implications arising from the use of non-genuine parts. Use of non-genuine parts may seriously affect the machine's performance and safety.

1.5.8 TRANSFER OF WARRANTY

Shelbourne may at its sole discretion allow this warranty to be transferred to a subsequent owner of the machinery for the balance of the Warranty Period, subject to all the warranty conditions being met and only with Shelbourne giving prior written consent.

1.5.9 EXPORT CUSTOMERS



- Always comply with safety rules as set out in the pictograms, and detailed in this Product Manual.
- 2 Keep Shear Bucket closed at all times, except during maintenance of blades, and when working.
- 3 The Shear Bucket must be used by the operator only, who will remain in the Prime Mover Vehicle (Tractor, or Material Handler) during the complete working cycle.

- 4. No bystanders must be allowed in the working area.
- Whatever the type of maintenance that needs to be done on the Shear Bucket, the Prime Mover Vehicle's engine must be stopped.

IDENTIFICATION OF THE MACHINE

The Shear Bucket is identified by a makers plate located on the top box section of the cutting frame.



HANDLING OF THE SHEAR BUCKET




If the Shear Bucket has to be moved, it is recommended that the locating holes on the support frame and on the cutting frame are used for locating lifting hooks

PREPARATION FOR WORK OF THE SHEAR BUCKET

 Before fitting the Shear Bucket to the Prime Mover Vehicle, check that the combined weight of the Shear Bucket and the heaviest Silage load does not exceed the manufacturers recommended safe loading of the front axle, wheels and tyres.

IMPORTANT




Fig. 2. Welded Bracket

If the Shear Bucket mounting brackets are to be welded to the Rear Frame of the Shear Bucket, it is absolutely vital that the welding is carried out by a Professional Welder. The material to be welded must be pretreated and the final welds checked carefully. (See Fig. 2.)

- 2. If the Shear Bucket mounting brackets are to be bolted to the machine, it will be necessary to drill through the back plate to accept the mounting bolts and straps which are used to bolt the brackets to the rear frame. (See Fig. 2A)
- The Shear Bucket requires a third double acting service on the Prime Mover Vehicle, operating at a minimum pressure of 136 Bar (2000 PSI), a maximum pressure of 205 bar (3000 PSI), and a minimum oil flow of 23 L/Min (5 Gal/Min).


Connect the hydraulic services to the Shear Bucket, using good quality double braid hoses, and slowly operate the hydraulic controls to ensure that the hydraulic pipes are correctly connected. Check visually, from a distance, that there are no oil leaks.

4. Open the Shear Bucket to the maximum opening, and fit the safety locking pin, Ref. A, Fig. 3. This will prevent the cutting frame from dropping when the Bucket is being worked upon.



Remove the guards and carefully, wearing heavy duty gloves, sharpen ALL of the cutting blades. Even though the machine is new, the blades lose their sharpness during their time through the factory and transportation. See maintenance chapter for full sharpening details.

Remove the safety locking pin and replace back into stowage hole, and reclip. Fig. 3 Ref B.



- 5. When driving with the Shear Bucket, always keep the Bucket closed, and as low as possible.
- 6. Check again for loose fittings, snagged, or chafing hydraulic hoses.

The machine is now ready for use.

SAFE USE OF THE SHEAR BUCKET

- Fully open the Shear Bucket, and raise it to the height where the Serrated teeth tips are just above, and clear of the block to be cut.
- 2. Level the Shear Bucket, and drive squarely into the Silage Clamp.
- 3. With the Shear Bucket front panel fully against the silage face, close the cutting frame.
- 4. Roll the Bucket back a few degrees to clear the remaining silage, then lift and reverse the machine out, clear off the silage face.



CAUTION

Note that it is vital that the Cutting Frame is fully closed before pulling back from the Silage face.

- 5. It is recommended that you start at one side of the clamp and work across the face. In this way a clean wall will be created with minimum wasteage.
- 6. When finished, close the Bucket before parking, and carefully put the loose hydraulic hoses into the bucket, away from the ground.

ADJUSTMENTS OF THE SHEAR BUCKET

There are no adjustments to be made to the Shear Bucket

MAINTENANCE OF THE SHEAR BUCKET

DAILY

1. Check blades for sharpness and damage. Although the blades are of high quality Blade steel, they must have regular attention or the performance of the machine will suffer.



Before work is done on the blades, first fully open the cutting frame and secure open with the safety locking pin. Put on a pair of heavy duty gloves.

Normally, only a few moments of filing will maintain the edge, but if the edge has serious nicks or burrs, then a heavy duty file must be used to repair the damage. (See Fig. 4.)






IMPORTANT

Note that a rotary grinder must not be used as it would generate excessive heat and destroy the temper of the steel.

2. Check hydraulic hoses and fittings for signs of wear and chafing.


WEEKLY



- 1. Grease all pivots, locations illustrated by Pictograms on machine
- 2. Check bottom plates for wear. (See Fig. 6.)

LONG TERM STORAGE

- a. Clean the machine thoroughly and paint over any bare surfaces
- b. Grease hydraulic ram rods
- c. Grease all cutting blades
- d. Completely close the Shear Bucket to protect the blades.



POSSIBLE DANGEROUS USES OF THE SHEAR BUCKET

- 1. The Shear Bucket must not be used to carry personnel, or animals.
- The Shear Bucket is a very strong machine with high cutting power, but it must not be used as a mobile guillotine around the farm.
- 3. It must be clearly understood that this machine is designed to cut and carry animal feed. If it is used as a standard bucket to carry materials such as metals, timber, rocks or aggregates, the blades will be irrepairably damaged and the machine will fail to function.

Damage in this manner will invalidate the warranty.
